Monday: Pentecost

Games

If you were here last year, hopefully you remember that we studied the Life of Jesus Christ. We learned about his birth, life, death, resurrection, and ascension. This year we are going to study what the Apostles did after Christ had bodily returned to heaven.

Read: Luke 24

Who were the first people to find that Jesus was no longer in His tomb?

Jesus walked on the road with two men. Did they recognize who Jesus was?

Did these men understand why it had been necessary for Jesus to die?

What did Jesus explain to them (Vs 27)?

After Jesus vanished, what did the men do?

Jesus then appeared to the disciples, in verse 47 what does Jesus say must be preached to all the nations?

How long were the disciples supposed to stay in the City?

Read: Acts 1-2

What did Jesus tell the disciples they would be baptized with?

How did the Angels say that Jesus would return?

Who does Peter preach about in chapter 2 verse 14-36?

How many people were baptized that day?

After Saul was healed of his blindness what did he immediately do?

Why do you think that the disciples were afraid of Saul when he first came back to Jerusalem?
